Form: double or more

Breeding History Set: cubensis

Foliage: solid

Position: pendant

Color: yellow

Notes: Quick grower with strong stems. Very good as a standard . Blooms to 13-14 inches long; 8 inches across the face. Flower color yellow-gold and varies with temperature to apricot heart. Fragrance very pleasant and has not much issue with mites.

Notes: This Nice white flower has a nice scent. In colder weather the blooms have a little green color. The plant is an easy grower.

Notes: Elegantly falling, massive flowers, the flowers are strongly split and about 40 cm long, lush .The flowers do not open as typically. Fragrance is mild and pleasant not intrusive and strong. Unique!

No pests.

Pleasant scent, fast growth., The color of the flowers is mixed - pink-orange-yellow

The flowers are wind resistant. So far I have not noticed that it is affected by broad mite.

Notes: GG New Born is a short and narrow Brugmansia, the length is 19 cm / 7.4 inches, the flower blooms for a minimum of seven days.

The colors are multiple on the flowers, we notice yellow, pink, melon, peach.
