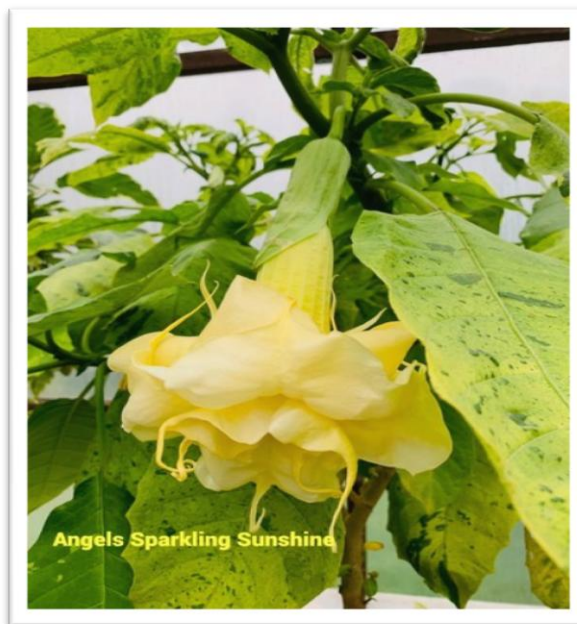
Pollen Parent: ‘Angels Summer Feeling’

Form: double or more

Position: pendent

Color: yellow

Notes: A variety with very beautiful variegated foliage. The main tone of the leaves is yellow-cream with darker green flashes. The more light there is, the more intense the color of the foliage becomes. The magnificent large blooms descend proudly. A real splash of color.

Notes: Very elegant flower. From single and double hanging to filled. Light pink to almost red. Very good grower and bloomer. Very elegant scent.

Notes: Fast grower. Beautiful hanging double flowers. The color is a very light salmon color. Very easy grower. Very pleasant scent.

Notes: This flower colors from yellow to orange and is 4 double. The scent is intense (everyone has their own opinion about this.) It is a good grower with masses of flowers. Very easy plant.

Notes: Very special flower. The flower has a diameter of 30 cm (11.811 inches) and is just as high. Very nice scent and is a good grower and bloomer.

Notes: Very pretty, fluffy, long lasting flowers with a rich filling. Robust growth.

Prolific bloomer producing numerous flushes. Disease resistant. Tolerates over wintering well. Grown from seeds from BGI seed bank by Ewan Reed**Brugmansia 'Cacaxtla'****Hybridizer:** unknown**Seedling Parent:** unknown**Pod Parent:** unknown**Pollen Parent:** unknown**Form:** single**Position:** Pendent**Color:** white/cream**Notes:** This brugmansia ,coming from Cacaxtla Mexico from the late 1990s, is worth registering because of its botanical characteristic and its associated fluffy leaves and snow-white flower color.**Brugmansia 'Clemson Tiger 00 Martin'****Hybridizer:** Alan Ashworth (UK)**Seed Parent:** Janice Lee (US)**Pod Parent:** 'Artus'**Pollen Parent:** Brugmansia arborea**Form:** single**Position:** nodding**Color:** lilac/purple**Breeding History Set:** arbovulsa**Notes:** It's hardy in zone 7, light lilac color, grows around 8 feet tall.

Brugmansia ‘Clemson Tiger 9 Etienne’**Hybridizer:** Edna Murphree (US)**Seed Parent:** Janice Lee (US)**Pod Parent:** ‘Ima Ten’**Pollen Parent:** ‘Theas Liebling’**Form:** double or more**Position:** nodding**Color:** gold**Notes:** Excellent bloomer and magnificent yellow/gold color.**Brugmansia ‘Edda’****Hybridizer:** Dirk Wenzel (DE)**Seedling Parent:** Dirk Wenzel (DE)**Pod Parent:** ‘Invicta’**Pollen Parent:** Brugmansia arborea**Form:** single**Position:** nodding**Color:** lilac/purple**Breeding History Set:** arbovulsa**Notes:** Edda is a robust and vigorous Cold Group cultivar that flowers lilac pink. As a daughter of B. arborea, it shows a light fragrance in the evening hours. Due to its robustness it could also be suitable for beginners.**Brugmansia ‘Firuze’****Hybridizer:** Marek Perniš (SK)**Seedling Parent:** Marek Perniš (SK)**Pod Parent:** ‘Zitronenkönig’**Pollen Parent:** ‘Rosa Ballerina’**Form:** double or more**Position:** pendant**Color:** very dark pink/red/burgundy**Notes:** A very nice new hybrid with robust growth and beautifully shaped, large flowers. Very nice play of colors.

Notes: Loves warm weather. A beautiful pink salmon color flower with a bit of a shiny touch.

Notes: Beautiful double yellow flower. Heat resistance is very good.

**Brugmansia 'GG Cléo'**

Pollen Parent: 'Orange Julius'

Form: single

Position: nodding

Color: pink

Notes: It is a small flower, both in cross-section and in length. She prefers cool rather than tropical temperatures. So far I haven't noticed broad-mite affecting it.

Notes: 'GG Continua' is a small double brugmansia. She has a very nice scent. The second skirt sometimes comes out completely, or hangs up so you can see it depending on the weather conditions.

Notes: The Flower is composed of yellow and orange. Does not like the heat, but prefers an environment of approximately 23°C / 73.4°F. The leaves are rather small. The flowers are wind-resistant. So far I haven't noticed broad-mite affecting it.

Notes: Blooms constantly. Nice waxy blooms with non-fuzzy foliage. Has 4 skirts that stay tucked closely but not stuffed.

Notes: Has a fluffy silver-colored surface over the entire plant, is an excellent bloomer even during the warmer days of the year for a sphaerocarpium, an excellent scent ! What is unique is the very special pink color with yellow combination. Easy to take cuttings!

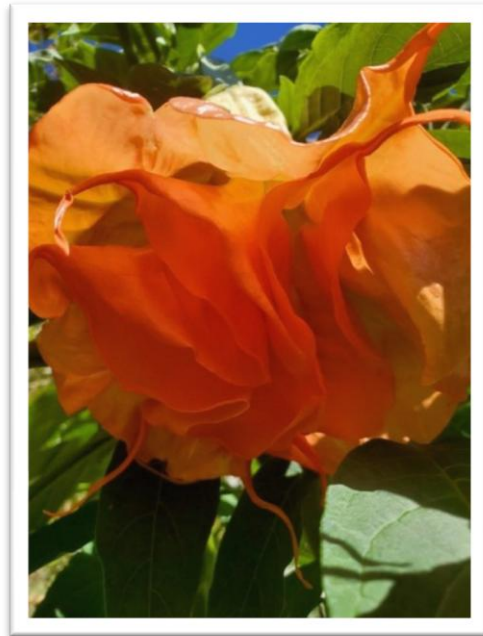

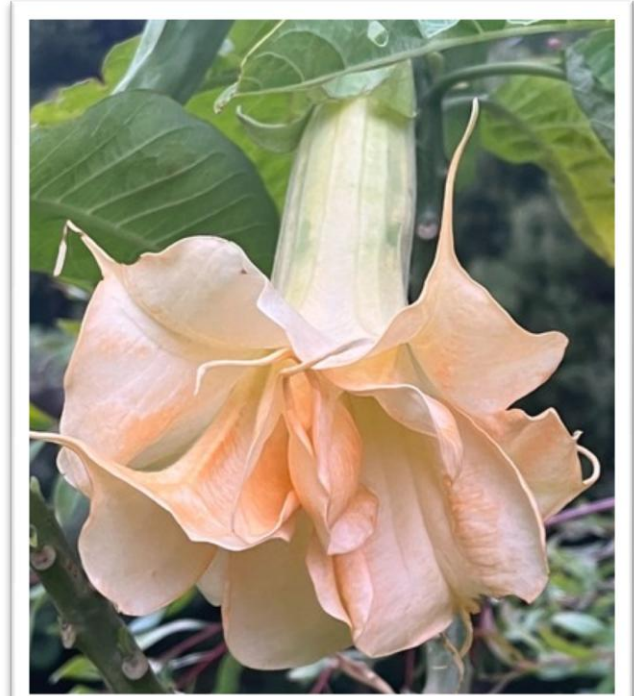
Notes: Healthy cultivar, blooming constantly, unusual color.

Notes: A very nice cultivar with large and well-shaped flowers with long petal tips. Slower growth.



Brugmansia 'Red Velvet'**Hybridizer:** Bernhard Saathoff (DE)**Seedling Parent:** Bernhard Saathoff (DE)**Pod Parent:** 'Artus'**Pollen Parent:** 'noid'**Form:** single**Position:** nodding**Color:** very dark pink/red/burgundy**Breeding History Set:** arbovulsa**Notes:** Very floriferous cultivar, red/dark-red blossoms, very intense at low temperatures with a velvety look.**Brugmansia 'Sarah Beth'****Hybridizer:** Eddie Stiltner (US)**Seedling Parent:** Harold Ray Dotson (US)**Pod Parent:** 'Jason's Hope'**Pollen Parent:** 'C Craig Coleman'**Form:** double or more**Position:** nodding**Color:** orange**Notes:** Very easy and fast growing plant that flushes lots of shiny orange flowers.**Brugmansia 'Solar Flare'****Hybridizer:** Ingrid Andrejsons (CA)**Seedling Parent:** Ingrid Andrejsons (CA)**Pod Parent:** 'DS Bijou pour Laetitia'**Pollen Parent:** unknown**Form:** single**Position:** nodding**Color:** orange**Notes:** Stunning fluorescent orange colour. Prolific bloomer producing continual flushes during the growing season. Compact disease resistant plant with dark green foliage. Propagates easily.

Quick grower who produces blooms all growing season. Propagates easily. Medium vanilla citrus scent.**Brugmansia 'Train 'R' Thought'****Hybridizer:** unknown**Seedling Parent:** Shaun Douglas & Phil Trainer (AU)**Pod Parent:** unknown**Pollen Parent:** unknown**Form:** double or more**Position:** nodding**Color:** apricot/melon/peach**Notes:** Exhibits robust growth, displaying excellent resistance to mites. The flowers may or may not possess cut inner petals. Furthermore, the color of the flowers can range from pale to bright apricot, particularly in response to fluctuating temperatures.**Brugmansia 'Zeus'****Hybridizer:** Amalia Venditti (US)**Seedling Parent:** Amalia Venditti (US)**Pod Parent:** 'Angel's Solar Flame'**Pollen Parent:** unknown**Form:** single**Position:** pendent**Color:** pink**Notes:** Very large flowers. Big leaves resistant to insects. Solid firm trunk. Intense scent at night. Color intensifies to a darker shade in summer.

Datura inoxia ‘Ghost’**Seedling Parent:** Mike Gilbert (NS)**Sport of:** *Datura inoxia***Form:** single**Position:** upright**Color:** white/cream**Foliage:** white on green**Seed Capsule:** spiny, pendent, splits evenly**Notes:** Comes true from seed.100% variegated but ranging from 70% green

To our knowledge, the following *Brugmansia* cultivar names have been placed in the public domain, on-line, or in electronic publications which do not meet the conditions of publication set out in the 2009 ICNCP specifically that they should appear in dated hard copy (Art. 25.1). Such names would be open to establishment for other cultivars, and their cultivars are open to having other names established for them. Therefore, in the interests of nomenclatural stability, we will establish them here. If it transpires that any of these have in fact already been established, then those names of course date from the earlier publication. It is to be understood that any epithets listed here are preceded by the name of the denomination class, *Brugmansia*.
